## FISCAL NOTE

HB 2310 - SB 2782

February 28, 2024

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Prohibits the knowing removal of a minor from the state without the consent of a parent of the minor if the purpose of the removal is to assist the minor in obtaining a medical procedure for the purpose of enabling a minor to identify with, or live as, a purported identity inconsistent with the minor's sex or treating purported discomfort or distress from a discordance between the minor's sex and asserted identity.

Authorizes a civil cause of action to be brought by a minor or the parent of the minor against a person alleged to have removed the minor from the state for such purpose. Requires the action to be brought within 10 years from the date the minor reaches 18 years of age, or from the date of the minor's death if the minor dies.
