FISCAL NOTE

HB 2645 – SB 2854

February 9, 2022

SUMMARY OF BILL: Directs the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations (TACIR) to perform a study of laws in this state and other states related to blockchains and to submit a report comparing and designating laws that create a positive economic environment for the use of blockchains to the General Assembly no later than January 1, 2023.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- According to information provided by TACIR, the study may be performed utilizing existing staff and resources; therefore, any increase in state expenditures is estimated to be not significant.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The proposed language will not result in any significant impact to jobs or commerce in Tennessee.
