AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 7, Chapter 51, relative to local government requirements on employers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-51-1802, is amended by adding the following appropriately designated subsection:

Except as otherwise provided by state or federal law, a local government shall not adopt or enforce any ordinance, regulation, resolution, policy, or any other legal requirement that regulates or imposes a requirement upon an employer pertaining to employee scheduling except when necessary to avoid creating a public or private nuisance.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
