

HOUSE BILL 415

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 54,
Chapter 5, relative to the installation of traffic
signals.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The department of transportation is directed to install flashing caution traffic signals in all directions at the intersection of State Route 111 and State Route 293 in Overton County.

SECTION 2. This act shall become operative only if Overton County, Tennessee, remits the estimated cost of the installation of such traffic signals to the department of transportation within one (1) year of the effective date of this act. Overton County shall make such payment prior to any expenditure by the state for manufacture or installation of such traffic signals. The department shall return any unused portion of the estimated cost to Overton County within thirty (30) days of the installation of such traffic signals. Overton County shall remit an amount equal to the difference in such costs to the department within thirty (30) days of receiving an itemized invoice of the actual cost from the department.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009, the public welfare requiring it.
