## **HOUSE BILL 779**

## By McCormick

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 6, relative to voting by members of the armed forces.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 6, Part 5, is amended by adding the following as a new section thereto:

2-6-504.

- (a) The coordinator of elections in accordance with § 2-11-201(c), shall promulgate rules and regulations to allow a person to return an absentee ballot by facsimile transmission or similar electronic means if the person:
  - (1) Is a member of the United States armed forces who is on active duty overseas; and
    - (2) Is casting a ballot from an area:
    - (A) In which members of the armed forces are eligible to receive hostile fire pay or imminent danger pay; or
      - (B) That has been designated by the president of the United States as a combat zone.
    - (b) The rules shall:
      - (1) Provide for verification of the voter;
      - (2) Provide for the security of the transmission; and
    - (3) Require a record to be maintained of each ballot received under this section.

SECTION 2. For purposes of promulgating rules and regulations, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, this act shall take effect January 1, 2010, the public welfare requiring it.
