SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-139, is amended by deleting subsection (c) in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

- (c) No person shall stand or conduct any activity in, or in proximity to, the median of a state highway without first having obtained permission from the department of transportation.
- (d) A violation of this section is a Class C misdemeanor; except, that a person who violates subsection (c) shall receive a warning citation for a first offense.
 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, the public welfare requiring it.
