AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2 and Title 49, relative to voter education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-2-111, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

( ) Each high school shall inform each high school senior that upon reaching the age of eighteen (18) the student may be eligible to vote and shall provide information from the secretary of state about voter eligibility and how to register to vote, including the date and time of the supplemental voter registration conducted at the student's high school pursuant to subsection (b). This subsection ( ) is not penal in nature. No punitive measures may be taken against the person tasked by the high school to provide the information.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
