AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 4, Part 9, relative to dual enrollment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-4-930, is amended by deleting subdivision (g)(5) and substituting:

(5) An eligible public postsecondary institution shall not charge a student receiving a dual enrollment grant under subdivisions (g)(2)-(4) tuition or fees in excess of the student's dual enrollment grant award, as established in the respective subdivision. However, an eligible public postsecondary institution may charge a student receiving a dual enrollment grant costs actually incurred by the institution on the student's behalf, including, but not limited to, book and material costs, digital book and material costs, special examination fees, industry certification fees, and board examination fees;

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2023, the public welfare requiring it.
