AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 4, relative to Silver Star license plates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-259(b)(3)(B), is amended by deleting the following language:

The Silver Star plates provided for in this section shall include an identification legend distinctive to recipients of the Silver Star. The legend shall read "Silver Star."

and substituting instead the following language:

The Silver Star plates provided for in this section shall include an identification legend distinctive to recipients of the Silver Star. The legend shall read "Silver Star – Valor."

SECTION 2. The department shall make the change required by SECTION 1 to the Silver Star license plates upon the exhaustion of the current inventory of the plates.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
