AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, Chapter 2, Part 6, relative to local health services.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-2-601, is amended by adding the following as new subsections (g) and (h) and redesignating the existing subsection (g) accordingly:

(g) This part does not grant a county board of health the power to prohibit or regulate agriculture as defined in § 1-3-105.

(h) County health departments shall not regulate agriculture as defined in § 1-3-105, except as otherwise authorized under state law.


SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
