HOUSE BILL 1269

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5; Title 6; Title 7; Title 13; Title 62; Title 67 and Title 68, relative to the regulation of swingers clubs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE: SECTION 1.

- (a) The department of commerce and insurance shall study the status of swingers clubs as a regulated form of operation in this state.
- (b) The department of revenue and the department of health shall provide assistance to the department of commerce and insurance in conducting the study required by subsection (a).
 - (c) The study shall focus on, but not be limited to, the following:
 - (1) Any activities or accommodations that are uniquely provided by swingers clubs that would assist the general assembly in determining how to define swingers clubs;
 - (2) Whether swingers clubs pose any threat to public health and safety; and
 - (3) The amount of revenue that would be required to administer the regulation of swingers clubs in this state.
- (d) The department of commerce and insurance shall report their findings together with any recommendations for legislation to the general assembly by December 1, 2015.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
