HOUSE BILL 1436

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 11, Chapter 14, Part 1, relative to state natural areas.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-14-108(b)(1)(C), is amended by deleting the word "County" and adding the language "and White counties" after the word "Putnam".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-14-108(b)(2), is amended by adding the following new subdivisions and redesignating the remaining subdivisions accordingly keeping the subdivisions in alphabetical order:

- () LOST CREEK. An area of approximately two hundred eleven (211) acres located in White County with habitat for the federally endangered Indiana bat and seven (7) globally imperiled cave dwelling invertebrates, six (6) of which are endemic to Tennessee;
- () WINDOW CLIFFS. An area of approximately one hundred nine (109) acres located in Putnam County with mesas, limestone arches, panoramic vistas, habitat for three (3) state-listed plants, a scenic waterfall, and a portion of Cane Creek; SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
