HOUSE BILL 1485

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102, relative to redefining theater for purposes of selling alcoholic beverages for on premises consumption.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(37), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision thereto:

- (_) "Theater" also means any establishment in which motion pictures are exhibited to the public regularly for a charge and which possesses the following characteristics:
 - (i) Is located in a county having a population of not less than three-hundred-eighty-two thousand (382,000) nor more than three-hundred-eighty-two thousand-one-hundred (382,100), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census;
 - (ii) Has one (1) auditorium restricted to patrons twenty-one (21) years of age or older; and
 - (iii) Is an eight (8)-auditorium theater that is one hundred percent (100%) digital;

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
