AN ACT to amend Chapter 137 of the Private Acts of 2004; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the titles of county officials in Sumner County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 137 of the Private Acts of 2004, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

Section 1. Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-6-101, the title of "county executive" in Sumner County shall be redesignated as "county mayor."

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Sumner County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body of Sumner County and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
