## **HOUSE BILL 1641**

## By Lamberth

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39 and Title 40, relative to conditions of release.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, Chapter 11, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

- (a) It is an offense to knowingly violate a condition of release imposed pursuant to this part.
  - (b) A violation of subsection (a) is a Class A misdemeanor.
- (c) A defendant shall not be convicted of both a violation of this section and a violation of § 39-13-113(i) if the facts supporting the prosecution arise out of the same criminal conduct.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-7-103(b), is amended by deleting the language "conditions of release imposed pursuant to § 40-11-150" and substituting "conditions of release imposed pursuant to chapter 11, part 1 of this title".

SECTION 3. This act takes effect July 1, 2024, the public welfare requiring it.
