

## State of Tennessee PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 786

**HOUSE BILL NO. 1716**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 16; Title 17 and Title 40, relative to judicial commissioners.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-1-111, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:
  - (i) In a county with more than one (1) general sessions judge in which the judicial commissioners are supervised by the general sessions judges, the management and supervision of any judicial commissioners appointed pursuant to this section must rotate between the general sessions judges having criminal jurisdiction in the county on an annual basis.
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-5-204, is amended by redesignating the section as subsection (a) and adding the following new subsection:
  - (b) In a county with more than one (1) general sessions judge in which the judicial commissioners are supervised by the general sessions judges, the management and supervision of any judicial commissioners appointed pursuant to this part must rotate between the general sessions judges having criminal jurisdiction in the county on an annual basis.
  - SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
