AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 17 and Title 68, Chapter 7, relative to qualifying medical diagnoses for the use of medical cannabis.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-402(16)(F)(ii)(b)(2), is amended by deleting subdivisions (G) and (H) and substituting:

(G) Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) or acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS);


(H) Sickle cell disease; or

(I) Quadriplegia; and

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
