

HOUSE BILL 1790

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, Chapter 11 and Title 62, Chapter 32, relative to occupational licensing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-11-107, is amended by deleting subsection (a) and substituting instead the following:

(a)

(1) The commissioner shall keep a register of all applications for licensure or for a licensee, showing on each the date of application, name, qualifications, place of business, place of residence, and whether a license was granted or refused.

(2) The commissioner shall cause the information contained in subdivision (a)(1) to be posted in a readily identifiable location on the department's website within thirty (30) calendar days of the date a license is granted or refused.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
