AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to higher education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-101(a)(3)(A), is amended by deleting the second sentence in its entirety and substituting instead the following language:

The statewide system of state colleges of applied technology, established under chapter 11, part 4, of this title, shall be composed of the state colleges of applied technology now established and located at Athens, Chattanooga, Covington, Crossville, Crump, Dickson, Elizabethton, Harriman, Hartsville, Hohenwald, Jacksboro, Jackson, Knoxville, Livingston, McKenzie, McMinnville, Memphis, Morristown, Murfreesboro, Nashville, Newbern, Oneida, Paris, Pulaski, Ripley, Shelbyville, and Whiteville. The board of regents is authorized to establish additional state colleges of applied technology or to combine existing state colleges of applied technology as needed to improve operational and administrative efficiencies.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


