

HOUSE BILL 1896

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62,
Chapter 4 and Title 63, relative to professions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be referred to as the "Tennessee Patient Safety Cosmetic Medical Procedures Act".

SECTION 2. The comptroller of the treasury shall prepare a report on the effectiveness of current rules issued by the board of medical examiners, the board of nursing, the committee on physician assistants, and the board of cosmetology, concerning patient safety during cosmetic procedures in this state. The report shall, at a minimum, identify areas of deficiency in the rules, including, but not limited to, lack of oversight in safety protocols, insufficient educational or training prior to the provision of services, and other such deficiencies. The comptroller shall present the report to the health committee of the house of representatives and the health and welfare committee of the senate on or before January 1, 2015.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
