AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 16, Chapter 18 and Title 18, Chapter 4, relative to notification to the Tennessee bureau of investigation of final disposition of criminal proceedings.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 18-4-103(9), is amended by deleting "seventy-two (72) hours" and substituting "three (3) business days".


SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 18-4-203(b)(4), is amended by deleting "seventy-two (72) hours" and substituting "three (3) business days".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-18-310(c), is amended by deleting "seventy-two (72) hours" and substituting "three (3) business days".

SECTION 4. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
