AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 56 and Title 68, relative to health insurance coverage of certain emergency medical transportation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. On or before December 31, 2016, the commissioner of commerce and insurance shall report to the speaker of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives concerning benefits and costs associated with the coverage of emergency medical transportation as an in-network benefit in health insurance policies even when an out-of-network provider is utilized. The commissioner shall consult with appropriate persons in the healthcare, health insurance, and emergency medical services sectors in developing the report and any recommendations. The speakers may refer the report to appropriate standing committees.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
