## PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 991

HOUSE BILL NO. 2116

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-302, relative to evaluations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-302(d)(2)(B), is amended by deleting the language "Fifty percent (50%)" in subdivision (i) and substituting instead "Sixty percent (60%);" by deleting the language "Fifteen percent (15%)" in subdivision (iii) and substituting instead "Twenty-five percent (25%)".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-302(d)(2)(B)(iv), is amended by deleting "the full fifty percent (50%)" and substituting "the full sixty percent (60%)".

SECTION 3. It is the intent of the 112th General Assembly that the evaluation criteria established in this act remain unchanged for a period of no less than three years from the effective date of this act.


SECTION 4. This act takes effect July 1, 2022, the public welfare requiring it, and applies to evaluations conducted for the 2022-2023 school year and each school year thereafter.
