AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-10-202, relative to constables.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-10-202, is amended by deleting the section and substituting instead the following:

(a) Each constable elected under § 8-10-101 shall complete forty (40) hours of in-service course time for each twelve-month period during which the constable holds office, beginning on the date the constable is sworn into office.

(b) This section does not apply to any constable with twenty (20) years of cumulative service as a constable before the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
