

HOUSE BILL 2171

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49;  
Title 62 and Title 63, relative to cardiopulmonary  
resuscitation training.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-1-120(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failure to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-1-111(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failure to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-2-308(a)(1), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Of failure to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-116, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and by adding the following language to be designated as subsection (b):

(b) No certificate of registration shall be renewed unless proof of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training is submitted with an application for renewal.

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-121, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failure to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-4-117, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

(g) All renewals of cosmetologist, aesthetician, manicurist, natural hair stylist, and instructor licenses shall be accompanied by satisfactory proof that the applicant has obtained cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training.

SECTION 7. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-5-317(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) The holder thereof has failed to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 8. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-6-116, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

( ) No contractor shall be qualified to receive a renewal license if such contractor has failed to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training.

SECTION 9. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-13-303, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

( ) No broker or affiliate broker license shall be renewed unless proof of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training is submitted with the application for renewal.

SECTION 10. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-18-114, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

( ) No certificate of registration shall be renewed unless proof of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training is submitted with the application for renewal.

SECTION 11. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-18-116(a)(1), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failure to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 12. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-19-111, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

( ) No license shall be renewed unless proof of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training is submitted with the application for license renewal.

SECTION 13. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-19-112(b), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failure to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 14. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-20-115(b), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failing to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 15. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-21-123(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision thereto:

( ) No license shall be renewed unless proof of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training is submitted with the application for license renewal.

SECTION 16. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-25-107(b), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failure to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 17. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-26-217(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failed to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 18. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-27-117, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failing to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 19. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-32-111, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failing to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 20. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-32-319(b), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failed to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 21. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-35-130(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failed to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 22. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-36-109(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Submit proof of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 23. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-38-204(g), is amended by adding the following language to the end thereto:

No license shall be renewed unless the licensee submits proof that such licensee has obtained cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training.

SECTION 24. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-38-309, is amended by adding a new subsection thereto, as follows:

(i) A permit shall not be renewed unless proof is submitted that cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training has been obtained.

SECTION 25. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-39-326, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failing to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 26. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-42-113, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failure to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 27. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-43-112(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Failure to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training;

SECTION 28. The Supreme Court is encouraged to establish guidelines to require attorneys to obtain cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training for renewal of their law licenses.

SECTION 29. Until supplies of existing printed application forms are exhausted by a specific board, the questions or notices required to be placed on each application under the provisions of this act may be attached as a separate question or notice.

SECTION 30. For the purpose of promulgating rules and regulations, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes this act shall take effect July 1, 2011, the public welfare requiring it.
