

HOUSE BILL 2261

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40,
relative to the department of correction.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-20-206, is amended by deleting the existing language in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

§ 40-20-206.

Notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the contrary, upon successful completion of a special alternative incarceration program, an offender shall be released to the supervision of the board of probation and parole under the terms and conditions imposed by the board for the balance of the original sentence imposed by the trial court. Should an offender fail to comply with the terms and conditions of supervision imposed by the board after successful completion of the program, the release on supervision may be revoked by the trial judge pursuant to § 40-35-311.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-20-303, is amended by deleting the existing language in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

§ 40-20-303.

Notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the contrary, upon successful completion of a technical violator program, an offender shall be released to the supervision of the board of probation and parole under the terms and conditions imposed by the trial court. Should an offender fail to comply with the terms and conditions of supervision imposed by the board after successful completion of the program, the release on supervision may be revoked by the trial judge pursuant to § 40-35-311.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
