## **HOUSE BILL 2295**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 8, Chapter 33, Part 1, relative to employees in military service.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-33-110, is amended by deleting such section in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

8-33-110. All officers and employees of this state, or any department or agency thereof, or of any county, municipality, school district, or other political subdivision, all other public employees of this state and all private sector employees who are, or may become, members of the Tennessee state guard and civil air patrol shall be entitled to an unpaid leave of absence from their respective duties, without loss of time, pay, position, regular leave or vacation, supplemental pay, impairment of efficiency rating or any other job-related benefit for all periods of service during which under competent orders they are engaged in the performance of duty or training in the service of this state, including the performance of duties in an emergency.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
