## **HOUSE BILL 2397**

AN ACT to amend Chapter 322 of the Private Acts of 1949; as amended and rewritten by Chapter 105 of the Private Acts of 2000; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to purchasing limits for the Town of Parrottsville.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 322 of the Private Acts of 1949, as amended and rewritten by Chapter 105 of the Private Acts of 2000, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended in Article IV, Section 4.07(b) by deleting the language "one hundred dollars (\$100.00)" wherever it appears and by substituting instead the language "five hundred dollars (\$500.00)".

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of the Town of Parrottsville. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
