HOUSE BILL 2822

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5; Title 6; Title 7 and Title 12, Chapter 4, Part 1, relative to public contracts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 12-4-109, is amended by deleting subsection (e) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

(e)

- (1) As used in this subsection "call center" includes a business entity that performs services, including but not limited to, data entry services, electronic governmental transfers, or other electronic, telephone and telecommunication services.
- (2) The state, including any of its departments or agencies, shall not enter into a contract after the effective date of this act for any services generally performed by or at call centers with a vendor, wherever located, who uses, or plans to outsource such services to be provided by, in or by any person residing in a foreign country.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5, Chapter 1, Part 1, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated section:

5-1-1___.

- (1) As used in this section "call center" includes a business entity that performs services, including but not limited to, data entry services, electronic governmental transfers, or other electronic, telephone and telecommunication services.
- (2) The legislative body of a county, including any county having a metropolitan form of government or county having a charter form of government, or any of its departments or agencies shall not enter into a contract after the effective date of this act

for any services generally performed by or at call centers with a vendor, wherever located, who uses, or plans to outsource such services to be provided by, in or by any person residing in a foreign country.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 6, Chapter 54, Part 1, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated section:

- (1) As used in this section "call center" includes a business entity that performs services, including but not limited to, data entry services, electronic governmental transfers, or other electronic, telephone and telecommunication services.
- (2) The governing body of municipality or any of its departments or agencies shall not enter into a contract after the effective date of this act for any services generally performed by or at call centers with a vendor, wherever located, who uses, or plans to outsource such services to be provided by, in or by any person residing in a foreign country.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

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
