AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4; Title 63 and Title 68, relative to executive directors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-10-307(a), is amended by adding the following language at the end of the subsection:

Once appointed, the executive director shall operate under the supervision and control of the division of health related boards.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-7-207(1)(A)(i)(a), is amended by deleting the subdivision and substituting:

(a) Employ, in consultation with the governor, an executive director, who must not be a member of the board, although the board is not bound by any recommendation of the governor. Once appointed, the executive director shall operate under the supervision and control of the division of health related boards.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
