## **HOUSE BILL 3054**

## By Watson

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 16, Chapter 2, Part 5 and Title 44, relative to policies regarding the entry of service dogs into courtrooms.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-2-505, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(f)

- (1) The security committee in each county, shall by October 1, 2010, formulate, publish and post a policy for such county relative to permitting hearing ear dogs, guide dogs, police dogs, search and rescue dogs and other such service dogs into the courtrooms of that county.
- (2) The policy described in subdivision (f)(1) shall establish at a minimum:
  - (A) The necessary credentials a person seeking entry into the courtroom is required to display to court officials to demonstrate that such person is in need of a service dog;
  - (B) The necessary credentials a person seeking entry into the courtroom is required to show court officials to demonstrate that the dog for which the person seeks entry is a service dog, properly trained as such or in training as a service dog;
  - (C) The leash, collar, vest or other indentifying item a service dog seeking entry into a courtroom must wear to gain such entry; and

- (D) Any restricted areas of the courtroom into which a service dog is not permitted.
- (3) The policy described in subdivision (f)(1) shall be consistent with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act, compiled in 42 U.S.C. § 12101 et seq. and any other applicable state or federal law that requires a public facility to be accessible to a person who utilizes a service animal.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
