HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 93

A RESOLUTION requesting actions to reduce the administrative burden on public schools.

WHEREAS, the administrative burdens placed on local education agencies often redirect valuable resources, including the time of school staff, from the mission of providing every student with a high-quality education; and

WHEREAS, the executive branch of state government is uniquely situated to identify administrative burdens that are duplicative and unnecessary; and

WHEREAS, the legislative branch of state government is uniquely situated to alleviate administrative burdens; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that the governor, the Department of Education, and appropriate committees of the General Assembly, as determined by the speaker of the senate and speaker of the house of representatives, are requested to conduct an examination of ways in which to reduce the administrative burdens on local education agencies and to submit recommendations to the General Assembly for making such reductions by December 31, 2025.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the governor is requested to actively solicit the input of public school parents, teachers, and administrators concerning the reduction of the administrative burdens on local education agencies and to incorporate such input into the recommendations submitted to the General Assembly.
