

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 165

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Angela Box of Jackson to the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201, provides for the creation of the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201, further provides that the Governor shall appoint nine members to the commission; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Haslam has appointed Angela Box of Jackson to a term that will expire on February 28, 2023, as a member representing the 8<sup>th</sup> District; and

WHEREAS, an esteemed businesswoman, Angela Box currently operates her own real estate investment company; for more than a decade, she has negotiated and completed numerous real estate transactions, managed many construction projects, and maintained a portfolio of real estate holdings; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201(b)(1), provides that each member appointed to the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission by the Governor shall be

confirmed by the House Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee and the Senate Energy, Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee and by Joint Resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,
