A RESOLUTION to honor and congratulate the Unity School Lions boys' basketball team upon winning the TMSAA Class A state championship.

WHEREAS, the Unity School Lions boys' basketball team is one such exemplary group of young men who reached an extraordinary level of success in winning the 2025 Tennessee Middle School Athletic Association (TMSAA) Class A state championship; and

WHEREAS, the other varsity Lions who excelled on the court during this championship season included eighth graders Will Byrd, Lawson Honey, Beau Watt, and Brody Wilson; seventh graders Jayce Jean and Hezzie Phelps; and sixth grader Maddox Groce; and

WHEREAS, junior varsity Lions Beau Bradford, Silas Bryan, Fletcher Byrd, Lincoln Caldwell, Heath Cunningham, Bentley Eakes, Silas Fugate, Garrett Marks, Walker McCain, and Jed Watt also earned the title of state champions by pushing their varsity teammates daily in practice and bringing remarkable sideline energy in games; and

WHEREAS, the Lions were led by Coach Stephen Bryan, whose calm demeanor, ingame adjustments, conditioning sessions, and inbounds-play wizardry were the stuff of legend; and

WHEREAS, under Coach Bryan, Principal Bridgette Jones, Assistant Principal Carrie Bradford, and Athletics Director Jennifer Medley, the Lions have grown not only as leaders on the basketball court but throughout their community, where they prominently serve in the Unity Student Council, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, and Beta Club and are key members of the baseball, football, Scholars' Bowl, soccer, and tennis teams; and

WHEREAS, the Lions were empowered by remarkable support from their community, who traveled en masse to every postseason game and filled the gymnasium at the state tournament in Murfreesboro; and

WHEREAS, during this incredible season, the members of the Unity Lions etched their names into the annals of Tennessee sports history, and the character, perseverance,
