WHEREAS, he returned to oversee the Nuclear Material Processing Group before becoming interim director of the Fuel Cycle and Isotope Division, director of the Global Nuclear Security Technology Division, and director of the Nuclear Security and Isotope Technology Division; and

WHEREAS, prior to his career at ORNL, Alan Icenhour proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy as a nuclear submarine officer; after leaving active duty, he continued service as a reservist and over a twenty-six-year career rose to the rank of Captain; and

WHEREAS, a gentleman of many talents, he is a Fellow of the American Nuclear Society and has served as chairman of the East Tennessee Economic Council; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Icenhour earned his bachelor's degree in nuclear engineering from North Carolina State University and his master's and doctorate degrees in nuclear engineering from the University of Tennessee; and
