

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 526

A RESOLUTION to request that the Department of Safety conduct a feasibility study of an online database of persons who have automobile insurance.

WHEREAS, drivers in Tennessee are required to possess proof of financial responsibility; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers would be assisted in the enforcement of such financial responsibility with a database of persons having automobile insurance in the state; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that the Department of Safety is requested to conduct a feasibility study of developing an online database of Tennesseans having proof of financial responsibility in accordance with Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 12, that would be accessible by law enforcement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Safety is requested to deliver the results of such study, including any recommended legislation, to the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Speaker of the Senate, and the Chairs of the Transportation Committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate no later than October 1, 2012.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives provide a copy of this resolution to the Commissioner of Safety.
