HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 661

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Shirley Currey to the education standards recommendation committee for English language arts and mathematics.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-312(a), requires the state board of education to adopt "[new] sets of standards in English language arts and mathematics that fit the needs of Tennessee students in kindergarten through grade twelve (K-12)"; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-310(a), requires that such standards "be adopted through an open, transparent process that allows all Tennesseans an opportunity to participate ... and fully implemented in Tennessee public schools in the 2017-2018 school year"; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-312(a), provides for the creation of the standards recommendation committee for English language arts and mathematics to facilitate such process; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-312(a), further provides that the speaker of the senate shall appoint three (3) members to the standards recommendation committee; and

WHEREAS, Lt. Governor Ron Ramsey, Speaker of the Senate, has appointed Shirley Currey to serve on such committee; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-312(b), provides that all appointments to the committee "shall be subject to confirmation by the senate and the house of representatives"; now, therefore,
