

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 750

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Charles Hankla to the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-7-104(a), provides for the creation of the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-7-104(b), provides that the governor shall appoint eleven members to the board; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Charles Hankla as a member of the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board, to a term that will expire on October 31, 2027; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hankla has thirty-five years of experience in selling and leasing industrial real estate, with a primary focus on representing landlords and tenants; he has held national sales and management positions with Sara Lee Corporation and Oscar Mayer and Company, and he also has extensive experience in project and development services and land acquisition and disposition; and

WHEREAS, he has been a member of the Society of Office and Industrial Realtors since 1992, serving at one time as the East Tennessee Chapter president, and has been a licensed broker in the State since 1984; and

WHEREAS, Charles Hankla is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-7-104(b)(2), provides that each member appointed by the governor to the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board shall be confirmed by joint resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that this body does hereby confirm the appointment of Charles Hankla to the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board for a term that will expire on October 31, 2027.
