

SENATE BILL 17

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4-409, relative to commissions received by county registers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4-409, is amended by deleting subdivision (d)(2), which currently reads as follows:

(2)

(A) For collecting and reporting taxes levied under this section, county registers shall be entitled to retain as commission five percent (5%) of the taxes so collected.

(B) Notwithstanding subdivision (d)(2)(A) or any other law to the contrary, fifty-two percent (52%) of the five percent (5%) commission provided by subdivision (d)(2)(A) shall be remitted to the state treasurer and credited to the general fund of the state.

and substituting instead the following:

(2) For collecting and reporting taxes levied under this section, county registers are entitled to retain as commission five percent (5%) of the taxes so collected.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, the public welfare requiring it.
