AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-15-716, relative to warrants.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-15-716, is amended by deleting the language "A civil action in the general sessions courts is commenced by a civil warrant issued by the clerk in substance as follows" and substituting instead the language "A civil action in the general sessions courts is commenced by a civil warrant being filed with the clerk in substance as follows".

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
