

SENATE BILL 160

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 11,
Chapter 14, Part 1, relative to State Natural Areas.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated Subdivision 11-14-108(b)(2), is amended by adding the following new subdivision (C) and redesignating the remaining subdivisions accordingly,

(C) BEAMAN PARK. An area of approximately 1,678 acres located in Davidson County that protects a diversity of high quality forest communities, barrens, and rare plant species including Eggert's sunflower, Michigan lily, lady's-slipper orchids, shortleaf pine, and butternut trees. Its natural features include ridges, narrow moist hollows with steep slopes, springs, streams and waterfalls representative of Western Highland Rim topography.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated Section 11-14-108(b)(2)(AA), regarding May Prairie is amended by deleting "two hundred fifty (250)" and substituting instead "three hundred forty six (346)".

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
