SENATE BILL 260

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 44; Title 47, Chapter 18 and Title 53, relative to meat.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 53-7-202, is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:
 - () "mRNA vaccine or vaccine material" means a substance to stimulate the production of antibodies and provide immunity against disease by introducing messenger ribonucleic acid (mRNA) that corresponds to a viral protein;
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 53-7-205, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:
 - (d) This section or another law does not prohibit a person from labeling meat or a meat product as "mRNA free" or any similar designation, if the animals from which the meat or meat product was derived were not administered an mRNA vaccine or vaccine material.
 - SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
