

SENATE BILL 307

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 70,  
relative to big game.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-101, is amended by deleting from subdivision (a)(4) the language "bear, wild hog, wild turkey" and by substituting instead the language "bear, wild turkey."

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-4-116, is amended in subsection (a) by deleting the language ", wild elk or wild boar" and by substituting instead the language "or wild elk."

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-4-116, is further amended in subsection (b) by deleting the language ", wild elk or wild boar" and by substituting instead the language "or wild elk."

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-4-116, is further amended in subsection (c) by deleting the language ", wild elk or wild boar" wherever it appears and by substituting instead the language "or wild elk."

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-4-116, is further amended in subdivision (d)(1) by deleting the language ", wild elk or wild boar" wherever it appears and by substituting instead the language "or wild elk."

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-6-202, is amended in subsection (a) by deleting the language ", bear, or wild boar" and by substituting instead the language "or bear."

SECTION 7. The commission is authorized to promulgate rules to effectuate the purposes of this act. All such rules shall be promulgated in accordance with Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 5.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, the public welfare requiring it.
