AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 8, Chapter 42 and Title 9, Chapter 8, relative to the defense of state employees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-42-101(3)(A), is amended by deleting the language:

"State employee" includes a foster parent under a contract with the state of Tennessee to provide foster home care for children in the care and custody of the state and within the confines of the foster parent-child relationship.

and substituting instead the language:

"State employee" includes a foster parent under a contract with the state of Tennessee, or with an agency under contract with the state of Tennessee, to provide foster home care for children in the care and custody of the state and within the confines of the foster parent-child relationship.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
