SENATE BILL 386

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 6, relative to immunization records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-5002(a), is amended by designating the existing language as subdivision (1) and adding the following as a new subdivision (2):

- (A) Notwithstanding subdivision (a)(1), the department shall accept outof-state medical records evidencing a child's immunization against one (1) or
 more of the diseases designated by the commissioner of health for purposes of §
 49-6-5001(a) as sufficient to allow the child to attend a school, nursery school,
 kindergarten, preschool, or child care facility in this state.
- (B) The department shall not require a parent of a child immunized in another state to present the child for medical evaluation in this state in order for the child to obtain a certificate of immunization.
- (C) This subdivision (a)(2) only applies to a natural or adopted child or stepchild of a member of the armed forces engaged in active military service of the United States or a member of the Tennessee national guard engaged in active military service of the United States.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2021, the public welfare requiring it.
