

SENATE BILL 497

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5,
Chapter 9, Part 1, relative to the Tennessee state
fair.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-9-102, is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

The county legislative bodies are empowered to make appropriations of money to provide for exhibits of their agriculture, horticulture, and mineral products and resources and manufactured products and the erection of buildings and other permanent improvements at the fairs to be held within the respective counties, and for exhibits of their agriculture, horticulture, and mineral products and resources and manufactured products and the erection of buildings at the Tennessee state fair, under the management of the Tennessee State Fair Association to the extent such management is approved by the department of agriculture, and to provide ways and means and prescribe rules and regulations governing the expenditure of any monies so appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
