AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 48, Chapter 101, Part 5, relative to the regulation of solicitations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-101-502(a), is amended by adding the following new subdivision:

(8)

- (A) An organization that files with the secretary of state a written statement, signed by an officer, director, or other responsible party of the organization, that the organization is an advocacy organization.
- (B) For purposes of this subdivision (a)(8), "advocacy organization" means an organization that:
 - (i) Is exempt from federal income taxation under § 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(4)); and

(ii)

- (a) Contacts, or urges the public to contact,
 members of a legislative or other government body for the
 purpose of proposing, supporting, or opposing legislation,
 executive orders, administrative rules, or other government action;
- (b) Advocates for the adoption or rejection of legislation, executive orders, administrative rules, or other government action; or
 - (c) Employs lobbyists.
