

SENATE BILL 559

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5;
Title 6; Title 7 and Title 55, Chapter 8, relative to
certain traffic enforcement cameras.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-198, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

() Unmanned traffic enforcement cameras shall be prohibited in any municipality having a population of not less than seventeen hundred twenty-five (1,725) nor more than seventeen hundred thirty-five (1,735) located in any county having a population of not less than one hundred fifty-six thousand eight hundred (156,800) nor more than one hundred fifty-six thousand nine hundred (156,900) according to the 2010 federal census or any subsequent federal census in a location where the municipality has extended its corporate limits by means of corridor annexation of a public right-of-way or any easement owned by a governmental entity or quasi-governmental entity but has not annexed parcels of property contiguous to the right-of-way, easement, or corridor on both sides of the entire length of the corridor annexation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
