## **SENATE BILL 727**

## By Campbell

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, relative to global positioning monitoring.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-11-150(b), is amended by redesignating the subsection as subdivision (b)(1) and adding the following new subdivision:

- (2) The magistrate shall order the defendant to carry or wear a global positioning monitoring system device and, if able, pay the costs associated with operating that device and electronic receptor device provided to the victim, pursuant to § 40-11-152, if:
  - (A) The magistrate finds the global positioning monitoring system device and receptor device are needed to protect the victim and to ensure the appearance of the defendant at a subsequent court proceeding;
  - (B) The defendant was arrested for a criminal offense defined in title 39, chapter 13, in which the alleged victim of the offense is a domestic abuse victim as defined in § 36-3-601, or a violation of an order of protection as authorized by title 36, chapter 3, part 6;
  - (C) The alleged offense or violation involved the strangulation or attempted strangulation of the victim or the use or threatened use of a firearm against the victim; and
- (D) A global positioning monitoring system is available in the jurisdiction. SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2023, the public welfare requiring it.
