SENATE BILL 730

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 10, Chapter 7, relative to open records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-503(a)(7)(A)(i), is amended by deleting the following language:

A governmental entity shall not require a written request or assess a charge to view a public record unless otherwise required by law.

and substituting instead:

A governmental entity shall not require a written request or assess a charge to view a public record unless otherwise required by law or as provided in subdivision (a)(8).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-503(a), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

(8) A records custodian may require a requestor to pay a fee to view records if the records requested reasonably require more than one (1) hour of an employee's time to collect for inspection by the requestor. A records custodian shall not assess a fee for the first hour an employee works on a request. After the first hour, the records custodian may charge a fee at an hourly rate that is in proportion to the rate of pay of the employee who is collecting the records.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
